## *Indo-Asia-Pacific International Maritime Security Expo (IMSE) 2018*

### **“Building Partnerships for Security, Stability and Prosperity”**

The 2018 Indo-Asia-Pacific International Maritime Security Expo (IMSE 2018) will be the first offering of a unique maritime conference and exposition devoted to regional security and economic prosperity in the Indo-Asia-Pacific Region (IAPR). IMSE will be held biennially in Honolulu, Hawaii immediately following the Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) 2018 Exercise.

The perennial conference theme is **Building Partnerships for Security, Stability and Prosperity**. Focus for IMSE 2018 is **Delivering Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief**.

IMSE 2018 will provide the opportunity for the industry to exhibit HADR-related products, services and technology and offer educational exchange opportunities for participants. Senior leaders will share their views on how to promote security, stability, and prosperity in the Indo-Asia-Pacific region through Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief. It will be an interactive, outcome-oriented event building relationships, sharing best practices, and facilitating partnership planning, training and mission execution.

**Audience:** Military, Civilian, Non-Government Organization (NGO) and International Organization (IO) practitioners and leaders from the IAPR to include the 26 Nations that will be participating in RIMPAC 2018.
